

3rd ABRALITEC INTERNATIONAL SEMINAR

The call for proposals for the Third Brazilian Association of English Language Teachers of the Federal Network of Basic, Technical and Technological Education International Seminar (III SIABRALITEC in Portuguese) are open until October 16th, 2020. The event's theme is: Critical approaches to the teaching of the English language and Anglophonic literatures at the Federal Education Network in a polarized society: perspectives, clashes and resistance. The event will take place from November 25th to 27th, 2020 online. The platform will be informed afterward.

For the Third SIABRALITEC, professors Hilary Janks (Witwatersrand University, Johannesburg, South Africa), Maria Auxiliadora Jacob (Minas Gerais State University), Kanavillil Rajagopalan (State University of Campinas), Leonardo da Silva (Federal Institute of Santa Catarina), Lynn Mário Trindade Menezes de Souza (University of São Paulo), Marcel Álvaro de Amorim (Federal Institute of Rio de Janeiro), Sávio Siqueira (Federal University of Bahia) and Vera Lúcia Menezes de Oliveira e Paiva (Federal University of Minas Gerais) have been confirmed as lecturers so far.

Abstracts can be submitted to the 3rd SIABRALITEC by teachers of Basic, Technical and Technological Education (EBTT) as well as teachers from other institutions. Teachers in the EBTT career must be a member of ABRALITEC. Thus, for those who have **not** yet joined ABRALITEC up to now, it is necessary to fill in the registration form and pay the annual fee for the current year. The registration form and proof of payment must be sent to abralitec@gmail.com. Application processing can take up to 4 (four) business days. For those who have already joined ABRALITEC, it is necessary to be up to date with their membership fees since the membership took place. The membership payment receipt must be sent to the e-mail mentioned above. (English) teachers from other institutions need to pay the event's participation fee and send the receipt along with the following information (full name and address, CPF, RG, or passport number, major degree – graduation, specialization, master's degree or doctorate – and name of the institution) to abralitec@gmail.com.

GUIDELINES FOR ABSTRACT SUBMISSION

Abstracts may be submitted in either English or Portuguese. They must have between 150 and 250 words and must include:

• Centralized title in capital letters (Times New Roman, font 12);



- Membership code (in members' case), or the letters NS followed by 6 (six) digits of the CPF (for teachers or professors from other institutions) or the passport number (for international participants);
- Presentation category (oral presentation, roundtable or poster);
- Main topic;
- An abstract of the work;
- Three keywords, separated by semicolons.

Abstracts must have the following elements:

- Contextualization / Rationale;
- Goals:
- Literature review / theoretical references;
- Methodological procedures;
- (Partial or final) results.

PRESENTATION CATEGORIES

Category	Time	Comments
Oral presentation	10 min.	An exposition on research in progress or completed. It must contain the elements mentioned in the guidelines above. 10 minutes will be available for discussion at the end of the session. For the accepted works, a no-longer-than-10-minute videos must be sent to the committee. If the author(s) is(are) not present during the evaluation time, the work will not be certified.
Poster (undergraduate students can only submit works in this category)	7 min.	Research exposition at a more incipient level (graduation and/or specialization). For the accepted works, a one-page pdf and a no-longer-than-7-minute video must be sent to the committee, covering all the elements mentioned in the guidelines above. It is necessary to answer all the questions and comments aimed at your poster for your work to be certified.
Workshop	2h (2 1- hour- meetings	Development of practical activities, described in the abstract of this presentation category.

Round table (restricted to ABRALITEC members)	30 min.	Proposals must be submitted individually. They will be organized according to the scientific committee's evaluation. 20 minutes will be available for questions from the audience at the end of the presentations.

MAIN TOPICS

- 6- The English language literature;
- 7- The English language teaching methods and approaches;
- 8- (English) teacher education;
- 9- Decolonization and English as a *lingua franca*;
- 10- The BNCC, language policies and the teaching and learning of English;
- 11- Corpus linguistics and the English language teaching and learning;
- 12- Minorized groups and the English language teaching and learning;
- 13 Other topics related to the English language and literature teaching and learning.

Notes:

- There is a limit of 3 (three) authors per work. Certificates will only be awarded to the authors who effectively participate in the presentation session.
- Due to the blind evaluation of the works submitted to the 3rd SIABRALITEC, the author's name and affiliation should only appear in the body of the email. If



any reference to the authors is found in the abstract, the submission will be disregarded.

- Abstracts should be sent as an attachment, according to the <u>abstract template</u> to the following email address: <u>resumos.abralitec@gmail.com</u>. The subject must be "3rd SIABRALITEC abstract followed by the main topic".
- The Scientific Committee may, in the evaluation process, suggest improvements in the work or suggest that it be allocated to another topic or to another presentation category.
- All accepted papers will be published in the Abstract Book.
- Authors who effectively present their work and who are interested in publishing the full texts of their research in the event proceedings should send them to trabalhoscompletosanais@gmail.com until December 20th, 2020.
- The full papers accepted will be published both in print and in digital versions in 2021.
- We would like to remind you that the proofreading is the author's sole responsibility.

In case the presentation proposal has not reached the minimum score (30/50) for approval in the first instance, a period of one week will be granted, counting from the date the suggestions were sent by the scientific committee to the author(s), so that the work is adequate to the rules and/or suggestions from the



3rd SIABRALITEC. The modified version should be sent back to resumos.abralitec@gmail.com. If the abstract is not submitted again to the scientific committee within this period or, even if submitted, has not followed the suggestions offered satisfactorily, it will be refused. ABRALITEC is not responsible for electronic problems, typing errors, or any other means that may make it impossible to send the final version of the abstract within the time frame established by the event's organizing committee. Certificates will only be granted to members up to date with ABRALITEC. To participate or present works at the event, in addition to the payment of the annual fee until 2020, the payment of the participation fee of the 3rd SIABRALITEC must be made, according to the table below:
